2. CEMETERIES

2.1 LAWN CEMETERY - MANAGEMENT

OBJECTIVES:

1. To reduce maintenance within the lawn cemeteries.
2. To improve the general appearance of the lawn cemeteries.
3. To give families the opportunity to provide a monument in keeping with their wishes which will not impact on Council.

POLICY:

1. That interment sites have turf and/or soil reinstated as soon as practicable following interment and flowers are to be returned to the site following restoration works. All such flowers are to remain on the site for a period of not less than 7 days, after such time flowers will be removed from the site.
2. Plastic flowers shall be retained by placing at the head of the site on the concrete strip. Such flowers will be removed as they deteriorate.
3. All flowers are to be placed in suitable receptacles for safety reasons. No loose glass containers are to be used.
4. That Council permit the installation of plaques in lawn cemeteries. Such plaques will be of a standard size of 381mm x 216mm. Plaques shall be ordered by the Council upon application and full costs of purchase and installation shall be met by the applicant.
5. Memorial headstones may be of hard stone including marble, granite or sandstone. Concrete headstones are not permitted. All headstones are to be approved by Council prior to the installation.
6. Council will provide a plan detailing the acceptable design upon the application for a monumental permit.
