4. COMMUNITY LIAISON

4.1 COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES - APPOINTMENT TO COMMITTEES OR WORKING GROUPS

OBJECTIVE: To provide a framework where Council may seek the support of, and involve members of the community in:

- the conduct of Committees in accordance with the provisions of Section 355 of the Local Government Act, 1993, as amended; or
- in the deliberations of Sunset Committees/Working Groups where such support and involvement is considered desirable by the Council.

To appoint the most suitable applicant(s) to the respective Committee or Working Group.

POLICY:

1. When Council resolves that community participation is required to assist the Council in the conduct of "Section 355 Committees" or nominated Working Groups of the Council:
 - Expressions of interest for community representatives to participate on such Committees or Working Groups will be called.
 - The appointment of community representative will be made by Council.
2. The appointments will have regard to the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1993 specifically:
 - Section 10 - Who is entitled to attend meetings;
 - Section 11 - Public access to correspondence and records; and
 - Section 12 - What information is publicly available.
3. Copies of any community representative personal information will be made available for Councillors only as a separate confidential enclosure.
